Position Title: Farmers Market Community Connector

Position Overview: Volunteers at the farmers market will sell coffee that is hand roasted and packaged in the Friendship House Café and raise community awareness of the mission and work done at Friendship House. Volunteers will get an opportunity to socialize with market guests about the opportunity for the community to support Friendship House. They will support an inflow of cash that allows Friendship House's residents to have access to quality coffee and healthy food. Volunteers who are excited about building community support around this programming will get a unique opportunity to directly share that excitement.

Position Details: For each market, volunteers are asked to pick-up sales booth items including a folding pop-up tent, weights, a folding table, two folding chairs, packaged coffee, and other sales supplies. Volunteers will then set up the booth at the market and remain for the entire duration of the market. Upon market close, volunteers will take down the materials and return them to Friendship House. Volunteers may be asked to manage other duties as requested.

Location and Time Commitment: The Mound Vernon Farmers Market is every other Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The Sedro-Woolley Farmers Market is every other Wednesday from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The market season for both locations is May to October.

Community Need Met: The mission of Friendship House is to reflect the heart of God by feeding, sheltering, clothing, and healing... to empower those in need. A Farmers Market Community Connector supports the ability to communicate with the general public about the exciting work that is happening at Friendship House while also selling coffee which is roasted as a work-skill learning opportunity for Friendship House residents.
